## Local Church Announces Community Grants, Seeks Proposals to Fund Additional Projects

Every Murder is Real (EMIR) Healing Center, Face To Face Germantown, Scouts BSA Troop 1719 (Boys), Scouts BSA Troop 1313 (Girls) and Cub Pack 1719 shared a special Easter Offering of \$15.500 received by First United Methodist Church of Germantown (FUMCOG). This offering brings the total contributed by the congregation over the past 20 years to \$324,000.

The Church's Community Needs Committee is seeking new proposals from the local community for projects that promote social justice or community empowerment, especially (but not exclusively) in Northwest Philadelphia. Grants in recent years have ranged from \$500 to \$5,000.

FUMCOG's members celebrate each Christmas and Easter by making a special offering for community needs. All proposals for the 2023 Christmas Offering are welcome now until November 17, 2023. They will be reviewed by a committee of church members, who will make decisions based on the size of the population to be served, the nature of the services provided, and expected benefits to the community.
